10 millions of victims

The scandalous fraud of thousands millions of dollars by Russian mafias from the loans given to the URSS since 1992 by the **IMF** (International Monetary Fund) has resulted in a human catastrophe ever since the end of communism.

A United Nations report concerning the cost of human lives during the economic transition to the free market, better said, the most brutal capitalism of the ex-soviet countries published one month ago, calculated the disappearance of 9.7 million young and middle-aged men from the population statistics since 1989. An absence – 5.9million from the Russian Federation and 2.6 million from Ukraine – which the report links to **“the growing rate of suicides, the decrease in life span, the collapse of the Public Health System and the increase of self-destructive behaviour”** among the masculine population.

The report titled *Transitions 1999* and prepared by the **Office for Europe and the ex-URSS** from the **United Nations Programme for Development**, points out that such transition **“has supposedly entailed an increase in the rate of poverty, crime, illness and mortality”** and that **“it has been literally disastrous for a great majority of people”**. Thus, if in 1989 there were **14 million people** in the old Sovietist bloc who lived on a daily income equivalent to \$4.00 (a little more than 600 pts,) five years later in 1994, there were **147 million people** with this same income. Likewise, the rate of crimes related to drug dealing was **five times higher** in Russia between 1991 and 1996.

The report also underlines the re-appearance of illnesses formerly eradicated in many of these countries such as tuberculosis, polio and anaemia due to the downfall of the Health System. The report also adds that corruption **“has been the only means of income for the millions of unemployed”**. The economy represents 25% of the gross national produce (GNP) of Russia and almost 40% in Yugoslavia, Armenia and Macedonia.

VICTIMS THAT “NOBODY IS INTERESTED IN”

Only through a corruption scandal has it made it possible to learn about the terrible increase of **mortality in men** in the ex-Soviet countries ever since the disappearance of the Soviet Union (it seems that these deaths were of no interest to anybody... or only to their mothers?).

A political change can cause, in only a few years, many more deaths than in the **Nazi Holocaust**, and perhaps even more tragic. But not in Jewish, **but in young men**.

The Soviet Union was, in its time, considered to have the shortest masculine life span relative to women in the world: men had a life span of **10 years below that of women**, which produced a “deficit” of **17 million men** in the URSS, to which we now have to **add 9.7 million**. Now, with an absence of about **27 million men**, it is not strange at all that prostitutes from the East have come to the European countries.

However, no political state is criticized because of early mortal rate in men, and not even by the most staunch enemy of such politics, or in the same way that no-one has denounced the sexual discrimination in the Obligatory Service (military or civil), not even pacifist groups or political parties which back them up.

It is badly “looked upon” to have sensibility over these deaths and we may consider it **ridiculous** to seriously investigate their causes. Perhaps this is why the Soviet Union collapsed unexpectedly and that it is now emerged in grave conflicts of culture which conceive the relationship between men and women from a different point of view.
